## **Camps With Meaning 2008 Bible Curriculum: “Peace... Live it!”**

### **SUNDAY: What is Peace?**

God's desire for the world is *Shalom*, the Biblical word for a peace that is broad, deep and complete.

#### **Bible Verses and Stories**

Matthew 6:25-34 Do not worry.

Mark 4:35-41 Jesus calms the storm.

### **MONDAY: Peace with God and God's Creation**

Part of being at peace with God is being at peace with God's creation and taking care of it.

#### **Bible Verses and Stories**

Genesis 1-2 The Garden of Eden.

### **TUESDAY Peace with Self**

We can have peace with ourselves as we accept and love ourselves as wondrous creations of God.

#### **Bible Verses and Stories**

Psalm 139: Note especially verses 13-14 where it says we were “Knitted together in our mothers’ womb”.

Luke 7:36-50 Jesus is anointed by a sinful woman and forgives her sins.

### **WEDNESDAY Today's theme is: Peace with Family, Friends and Enemies**

Jesus can help us to be at peace with others.

#### **Bible Verses and Stories**

Luke 10:25-37 The Good Samaritan.

Genesis 37:12-36/Genesis 45:1-15 Joseph is reconciled to his brothers after being sold by them into slavery.

### **THURSDAY Today's theme is: Blessed are the peacemakers – Peace with others**

Jesus was a radical example of a peacemaker. We can be peacemakers, both corporately and individually.

We work with Jesus (and for Jesus).

#### **Bible Verses and Stories**

1 Peter 2:21-24 Christ suffered for us, leaving us an example.

Luke 19:1-10 Zacchaeus the Tax Collector.

### **FRIDAY Today's theme is: Blessed are the peacemakers – World Peace**

Bringing peace and justice does not mean sitting by and watching; engage in mediation rather than violence.

#### **Bible Verses and Stories**

Isaiah 2:2-5 One day, swords will be beaten into ploughshares and nations will not fight other nations.

Mark 11:12-19 Jesus clears the temple (cleans up unjust operations).

### **SATURDAY Today's theme is: Go in peace.**

Know that Jesus is the source of our peace. Jesus wants a relationship with us forever.

#### **Bible Verses**

John 3:1-21 Jesus teaches Nicodemus.

Revelation 22:1-5 The perfect garden.
